Program Speakers and Topics



Paul A. Anderson, MD, is a nationally recognized expert in spinal trauma and complex cervical spine disorders. He earned his medical degree and completed his residency at Wayne State University, Detroit, MI. He completed a spine surgery fellowship at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, OH. His research specialties include spinal fixation implants

and the development of an artificial cervical disc. Dr. Anderson's presentations, ***Bone Health Optimization***, will address multidisciplinary implementation considerations for secondary fracture prevention and bone health optimization of patients, the role orthopedists should assume in identifying patients who require testing, recommend life style changes, and provide pharmacologic therapy direction for patients. ***Quality Improvement in Orthopedics*** will address how to provide efficient orthopedic care and increased patient safety using principles derived from the manufacturing industry such as Six sigma and LEAN.



Paul M. Lafferty, MD, is a traumatologist at Regions Hospital in St. Paul MN where his clinical interest is malunion/nonunion, periarticular fractures, and orthopaedic trauma. He has a keen interest in MRI techniques for assessment of articular injury in trauma, pelvis and acetabulum fractures and osteomyelitis. He received his MD at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of

New Jersey— New Jersey Medical School in Newark, NJ and completed his residency at the Hospital for Joint Diseases Orthopaedic Institute in NJ. Dr. Lafferty's presentations will address the following: ***Humeral Shaft Fractures*** where we will learn about the current state-of-the art treatment and identify when nonoperative and operative interventions may be best applied; ***Pediatric Ankle Fractures*** provides new information on how to diagnose and manage common pediatric ankle fractures using improved diagnosis to determine nonoperative and operative interventions; ***Physician Burnout*** educates on how to identify signs of physician burnout and strategies to avoid or remedy burnout; ***Semi-Extended Tibia Nailing*** educates on how to identify tibial shaft fracture patterns that may be best suited to semi-extended nailing technique treatments; ***Submuscular Plating of Pediatric Femoral Shaft Fractures*** identifies appropriate indications and improved diagnosis of submuscular plating of pediatric femur fractures.
